Swan Hill Regional Library has partnered with St Mary MacKillop College, to run *The Be Connected Young Mentors* program.

The Be Connected Young Mentors program supports older Australians to improve their digital skills by bringing them together with young people in a mentoring capacity, to share digital skills and knowledge.

The initiative is aimed at enhancing digital skills through fostering connections between younger and older generations.

The *Young Mentors* program gives young people an opportunity to make a real difference to the lives of our older residents.

Participants have been learning useful tasks such as using mobile phones, tablets and computers, sending emails, video chat, getting directions on google maps and more. They are encouraged to use their own devices, allowing them to put their new skills straight to practice.
