Terms & Conditions - Big Summer Read 2025

Overview

The Big Summer Read is an annual reading challenge developed and run by Public Libraries Victoria (PLV).

The objective of the challenge is to promote literacy and reading to avoid the 'summer slide', a term used to describe the 'loss of literacy skills over the summer holidays when children do not read'.

1. How to register for PLV Big Summer Read 2025

- a) Entrants enter by signing up for PLV Big Summer Read <u>here</u>.
- b) By signing up to PLV Big Summer Read, entrants are placed in the statewide competition / draw for prizes.
- c) Upon registration, entrants must agree to the terms and conditions of PLV Big Summer Read 2025.
- d) Books are logged via PLV's user friendly website readbooks.com.au
- e) Please note that Swan Hill Rural City Council is not responsible or liable for the management of PLV's Big Summer Read 2025 challenge

2. How to participate in Swan Hill Library's Big Summer Read 2025 Competition

- a) Visit Swan Hill Library, Robinvale Library or 'Libby' our Outreach Vehicle to sign up to the local BIG Summer Read competition to receive a reading log or download one from here: <u>BIG Summer Read Swan Hill</u>.
- b) Write down the titles of the books you've read or the number of hours you have read—one book or 30 minutes per line.
- c) Submit your reading log to one of the above branches, OR email your Big Summer Read reading log to library@swanhill.vic.gov.au

3. Terms and Conditions - Swan Hill Library - Big Summer Read 2025

- 3.1 Entry into the competition means you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions:
 - a) The Promoter is Swan Hill Rural City Council.
 - b) Entry is open to all residents of Swan Hill Rural City Council age 0 18 (online) or 5 – 18 (in-branch). Immediate families of Council employees and Councillors are encouraged to participate in the Big Summer Read challenge; however, immediate family members will not be eligible to win prizes at Swan Hill Rural City Council.
 - c) Entrants must be a member of Swan Hill Regional Library. Library membership is free. Sign up here: Sign up to become a library member Swan Hill.

3.2 The competition:

- a) Commences on Monday 1 December 2025; and
- b) Closes on Saturday 31 January 2026
- c) Participants can commence the Big Summer Read challenge at any point during this time.
- d) Entrants are encouraged to read either:
 - i. 30 minutes per day (chapter books) a minimum of 10 times

<u>Or</u>

- ii. 10 picture books
- e) Entrants need to log their reading achievements in a Big Summer Read reading log. The reading logs can be collected at the above Swan Hill Library branches, or alternatively downloaded at <u>BIG Summer Read 2025 Swan Hill</u>
- f) For every 10 picture books read, OR Chapter books read 30 minutes per day, a minimum of 10 times entrants are to submit their reading log to Swan Hill

Library. Submissions of the Big Summer Read Reading Logs can be handed in in person, or alternatively, emailed to library@swanhill.vic.gov.au

3.3 Prize Draw Selection

- a) All completed entries will be placed in the prize draw.
- b) Entrants can submit an unlimited number of reading logs into the draw.
- c) The more books you read, the more chances you have to win a prize.
- d) Winners will be drawn at random on Friday 6 February 2026 by the Libraries Manager at Swan Hill Regional Library.
- e) The winners will be notified by 5:30pm Monday 9 February 2026. The winners will be notified of their prize via phone and on the promoter's social media platforms &/or website.
