



Tech Savvy Seniors

The Seniors Card Age Friendly Partners Program is designed to give older people, particularly those in regional and rural areas of Victoria, the chance to develop their skills in using technology.

In partnership with the Swan Hill Regional Library, Swan Hill Neighbourhood House will run free tutorials for seniors starting in October. The tutorials will cover the following topics - using the Internet, banking, shopping and paying bills online, using social media, email and tablets.

The Library also has several Tech Savvy Seniors training DVDs which library members can borrow. The DVDs cover topics like internet security, using e-readers, using mobile phones and tablets, social networking and home networking.

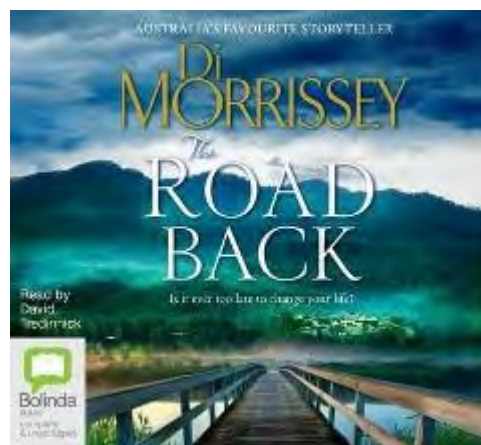

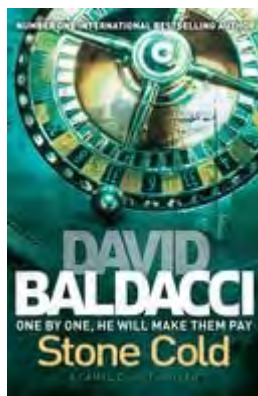
Journalist Chris Baxter is at a crossroads. Returning with his teenage daughter to his mother's house in the beautiful township of

Get homework help with 'yourtutor'

Free online study help for local students

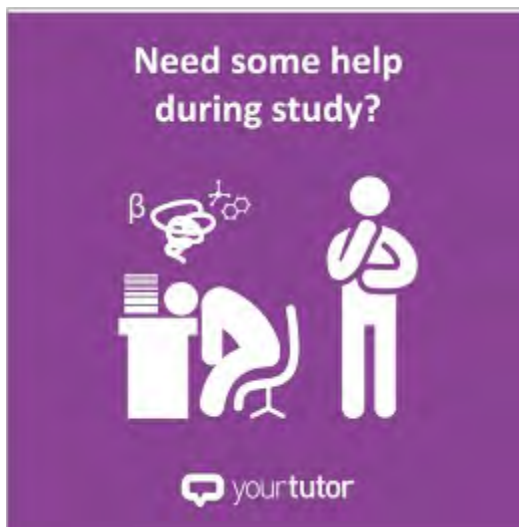
Homework is your chance to participate in your child's education - but it's not always easy. That's why the library offers on-demand online study help, in the form of 'yourtutor'.

Whenever students get stuck on a homework question or study problem, a real live teacher or tutor is ready online to help them get 'unstuck'.

Each time a student logs in with a question, they enter a live, interactive one-to-one 'tutorial' and are guided through their problem, encouraged to learn and think for themselves (not 'given' the answer).

It's simple - students just log in online via the library's website, using their library card number. Why not join hundreds of local families who are already getting help right when they need it? Try out **yourtutor** next time your kids are doing homework. It's quick, easy and 100% free, thanks to your library. Help is available Monday to Friday, 4pm-8pm (even throughout the school holidays!)
